



ETHICAL CHARTER

Chinese Classical Dance Association

Chapter 1: The Ethics of the Association

The association is a space for learning, cultural exchange, and personal growth through Chinese classical dance.

It is open to anyone wishing to discover, practice, or support dance and the related arts.

The key values of the association are: respect, kindness, and solidarity. Each member commits to participating in this spirit, without judgment or exclusion.

The association is not intended for competition, nor for political or religious indoctrination, but rather to foster beauty, harmony, and togetherness.

Chapter 2: Image and Commitments of the Association towards the Outside

The association commits to:

- not associating its image with partners or projects contrary to its values;
- not engaging in political, religious, or sectarian activities;
- promoting dance as a cultural and artistic practice, in a spirit of openness and respect.

Chapter 3: Ethical Rules towards Teachers and Guest Instructors

The association commits to:

- providing a respectful framework for the transmission of knowledge;
- recognizing the role and expertise of teachers and instructors;



- providing the necessary tools and information to ensure the smooth running of classes and workshops.

The teacher or instructor commits to:

- respecting the statutes, internal regulations, and the ethical charter;
- transmitting knowledge with respect, without discrimination or judgment;
- fostering an atmosphere of listening, trust, and artistic progress;
- respecting students and volunteers in their commitment.

Chapter 4: Ethical Rules towards Members

The association commits to:

- protecting members' personal data (in accordance with GDPR);
- offering activities that are accessible, non-competitive, and non-discriminatory.

The member commits to:

- respecting this charter as well as the internal regulations;
- being punctual and diligent to ensure a good group dynamic;
- adopting a respectful attitude towards the teacher, volunteers, and fellow dancers;
- encouraging, supporting, and contributing to a caring atmosphere;
- refraining from hurtful behavior (mockery, unfair criticism, conflict).

Chapter 5: Ethical Rules towards Volunteers and Partners

The association commits to:

- valuing and recognizing the contribution of volunteers;
- working in respect of the ethical principles of cultural and associative partners.

The partner commits to:

- respecting the values and image of the association in any collaboration.



Chapter 6: Living Together and Collective Spirit

Every actor in the association (member, teacher, volunteer, parent, partner) commits to fostering an atmosphere of trust and mutual respect.

Dance, as an art of the heart, can only flourish through cooperation, kindness, and sharing.
